CUBANS IN THE U.S.

Andrés Gómez has, for many years, been the editor of *Areíto*, a journal on Cuban culture and politics published in Miami. He is currently the Coordinator of the National Network on Cuba, the umbrella organization for all groups in the US and Canada working for an end to the US embargo against Cuba and for the normalization of relations between the two countries. He was one of the founding members of the Antonio Maceo Brigade, the first initiative of active support for the Cuban Revolution arising from the ranks of Cuban exiles in the US in the 1970's. He is a frequent visitor to Cuba and a much sought-after Cuban-American speaker in support of the present Cuban government. He will describe the many groups of Cuban-Americans supporting the Cuban Revolution, kept invisible by the US media, and will provide a portrait of the present Cuban reality.
