The RBT Training course will provide students with a comprehensive understanding of the basic principles of Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA). The course covers various topics related to ABA, including an introduction to behavior analysis, introduction to Autism, components of reinforcement, skill acquisition techniques when working with individuals on the spectrum, and responding to and preventing challenging behavior. Upon completion of the course, each student will have completed the requirements to submit an application to sit for the **Registered Behavior Technician (RBT) examination** through the Behavior Analyst Certification Board (BACB). The RBT credential is a nationally recognized accreditation and an excellent stepping stone into a career in the field of behavioral health.

WHAT IS A REGISTERED BEHAVIOR TECHNICIAN?

A Registered Behavior Technician is certified to assist in delivering behavior-analytic services under the supervision of a Board Certified Behavior Analyst (BCBA). RBTs most commonly provide direct 1:1 services to individuals with Autism Spectrum Disorder. Examples of an RBT's job responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- Implementing functional communication training programs
- Implementing function-based behavior intervention services
- Applying the principles of reinforcement
- Teaching social skills

JOB OUTLOOK



The Bureau of Labor and Statistics projects employment of Psychiatric Technicians and Aides (RBT included) will **increase 11% between 2020 and 2030**. As funding sources continue to increase, the need for RBTs is expected to continue to grow. (bls.gov)

SALARY



The average Registered Behavior Technician (RBT) salary in the United States ranges from **\$40-\$60,000**, varying from an hourly rate of **\$15-30 per hour**, depending on the location, type of service provided, and funding source requirements. (Elemy)

CERTIFICATION



Graduates of this course will be prepared for the **Registered Behavior Technician (RBT) Certification Exam**, provided by the **Behavior Analysis Certification Board (BACB)**. The certificate requires yearly renewal.
