

HEALTH CAREERS CERTIFICATE

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Program Overview

29 credit hours - Program Code: CHECA

The Health Careers Certificate is a one-year program designed to prepare students for admission into competitive associate degree programs in the health sciences, including Nursing, Radiologic Technology, Anesthesia Technology, and related allied health fields. The program provides focused instruction in key prerequisite science and general education courses required for entry into selective health programs. It is intended for students seeking a structured pathway to complete prerequisite and foundational coursework before applying to a degree granting health science program. Students are encouraged to work closely with an academic advisor to ensure alignment with the specific admission requirements of their intended program.
