

# THE TESTING CENTER

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Most new students are required to take the Self-Guided Placement which assesses readiness for college-level English and mathematics courses. There is no "pass" or "fail"—your scores simply help determine whether you should begin in college-level or developmental coursework. Students may take the Self-Guided Placement Test once within a 12-month period. Placement testing is also required for non-degree and dual-enrollment students unless an exemption applies.

### **High School Equivalency Testing (HiSET and GED)**

RCC offers both the HiSET and GED exams, providing students with pathways to earn a high school equivalency credential and demonstrate college readiness.

### **Credit by Examination (CLEP)**

Students may also take College-Level Examination Program (CLEP) tests to earn college credit for knowledge gained outside the classroom, allowing them to accelerate their academic progress.

### **TEAS Testing**

The TEAS (Test of Essential Academic Skills), required for admission to certain healthcare programs, is offered in person at RCC at the beginning of the Fall and Spring semesters.
