 - Negative TB skin test, chest x-ray or blood test within 6 months
 - Physical Exam within 12 months



WHAT DO CLINICAL MEDICAL ASSISTANTS DO?

A Certified Nursing Assistants provide direct patient care under the supervision of registered nurses (RNs) or licensed practical nurses (LPNs) in various healthcare settings. They are a vital part of the healthcare team, providing essential care and support to patients and helping to maintain their overall well-being, and their responsibilities typically include:

- Basic patient care
- Vital signs monitoring
- Infection control
- Mobility assistance
- Updating and filing patient medical records
- Performing basic laboratory tests

JOB OUTLOOK



The Bureau of Labor and Statistics projects overall employment of Nursing Assistants in Massachusetts is projected to grow 6 percent from 2022 to 2030.

SALARY



The average Certified Nursing Assistant salary in Massachusetts is **\$38,492** as of August 27, 2023, but the range typically falls between **\$35,267** and **\$42,387**. Massachusetts is one of the top paying states of Nursing Assistants with the median hourly wage **\$18.83**. (bls.gov)
