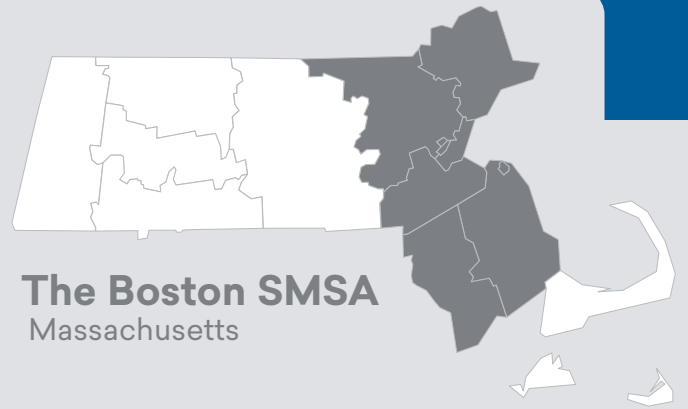

Added income

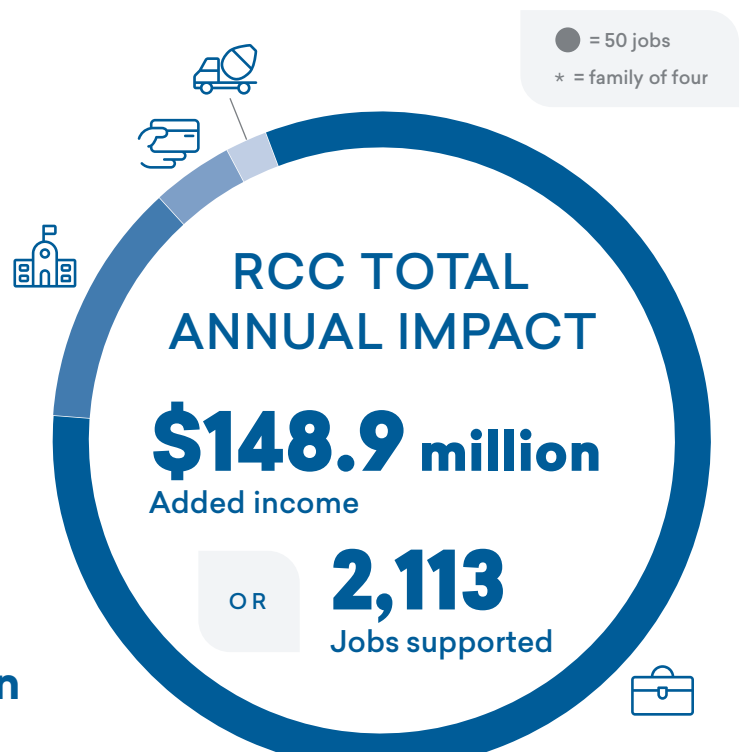
Enough to buy **462** families* a year's worth of groceries

INVESTMENT ANALYSIS

For every \$1...

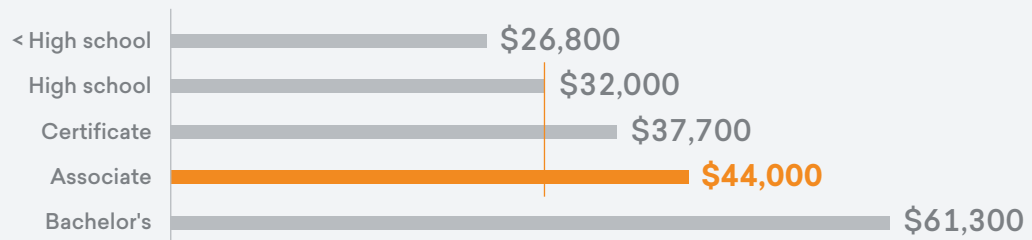
Students gain **\$8.40** in lifetime earnings

Society gains **\$6.70** in added income and social savings

In total...

Massachusetts taxpayers gain in added tax revenue and public sector savings
\$21.3 million

The average associate degree graduate from RCC will see an increase in earnings of **\$12,000** each year compared to someone with a high school diploma working in Massachusetts.
